

On Friday and Saturday, August 13 and 14 Germantown will play host to a new blues festival. The Germantown Blues Festival is a collaborative effort between Zeppelin Cafe, Check's Cafe and the Kentuckiana Blues Society. One dollar from every beer sold at the festival will go to the Musician's Emergency Resource Foundation (MERF) general fund. MERF was founded in 1981 with the goal of helping local musicians in need. The headliner for Friday night is Governor Davis and the Blues Ambassadors. Davis (top left photo) and his band are from Indianapolis and have been playing together for more than 15 years. They have represented the Crossroads Blues Society of Indiana at the International Blues Challenge in Memphis and have opened for many national blues acts including Junior Wells, Koko Taylor, Lonnie Brooks and Bonnie Raitt. Saturday's headliner is the Nick Stump Blues All-Stars. Stump (top right photo) and his bands have played around the Kentuckiana area for many years. Most people know him from his time spent with the Metropolitan Blues All-Stars who toured the country in the 1980's and early 1990's. Nick is sure to shake the neighborhood with his brand of rocking, hillbilly blues. Check out the full line-up in this issue of Blues News.

I love a good summertime street festival. They close off the streets. They set up a stage. The sun goes down, the music gets turned up and then everyone is dancing in the streets. The corner of Burnett Ave and Hickory St will be transformed into such a scene the second weekend of August. Thanks to the support of Tim Cain of Zeppelin Cafe and John Murrow of Check's Cafe Germantown will host its first blues festival. The Kentuckiana Blues Society is a participating sponsor and to help make this a good cause \$1.00 from every beer sold will be contributed to the Musician's Emergency Resource Foundation general fund. So join us in Germantown on August 13 and 14 because we have a cure for those summertime blues.

The third weekend of August marks the return of the best blues festival southern Indiana has to offer. The Ninth Annual Ribberfest takes place on the banks of the Ohio River in Madison, IN on August 20 and 21. Every year Madison just seems to get a little better and this year is no exception with national blues artists Delbert McClinton, Davy Knowles, Jimmy Hall, Stacy Mitchhart, Theresa James and Big

Al Lauro on the bill. Kentucky is also well represented with Greg Foresman, Hambone and Tyrone Cotton. Make your hotel reservations as soon as possible or you may be staying in Dillsboro.

August gets us into the thick of the blues festival season. In addition to Germantown and Ribberfest there is the Cincy Blues Fest in Cincinnati, OH on August 6 and 7 (cincyblues.org), the Blues, Cruise & BBQ Festival in French Lick, IN on August 13 and 14 (bluescruiseandbbq.com), the Capital City Blues Festival in Frankfort, KY on August 20, the Bean Blossom Blues Festival in Bean Blossom, IN on August 27 and 28 (beanblossomblues.com) and the Hot August Blues Festival in Hardin, KY on August 27 and 28 (hotaugustbluesfestival.com).

If you don't want to leave Louisville for any of these festivals there are plenty of national blues acts coming into town this month. Janiva Magness will be at the Vernon Club on Friday, August 13. Stevie Ray's will feature no less than five national acts with the Eric Tessmer Band on Wednesday, August 4, Shane Dwight on Thursday, August 5, Tab Benoit on Thursday, August 12, Cedric Burnside and Lightning Malcolm on Monday, August 16 and Big Al and the Heavyweights on Friday, August 20.

As we go to press with this issue of *Blues News* we are still looking for applications for our solo/duo contest which takes place at Lisa's Oak Street Lounge on Sunday, August 15. Provided we receive enough interest to have a contest it will start at 4:00 pm at the bar which is located at 1004 East Oak Street. Call me at 502/724-9971 for more information.

Thanks to everyone who came out to the Louisville Blues-n-Barbecue Festival at the water tower last month. The blues festival set a single day attendance record with the crowd on Saturday, July 10. Your support of the blues is greatly appreciated and we'll do it again next year. Thanks also to the Bisig Impact Group for their continued support of local blues music. 

# **New Music Reviews!**





# Chris James and Patrick Rynn Gonna Boogie Anyway Earwig Music 4960CD

This follow up CD to the 2008 release of "Stop and Think About It" is what I was hoping for. This duo, formerly from Chicago, but now from San Diego, thoroughly impressed me with their first release and has recorded another knock-out. Their music is traditional blues from Chicago and Delta influences. James plays guitar and sings while Rynn plays bass. The third piece of their songwriting trio is Rob Stone who plays harp. Together, they form a songwriting team that is more than the sum of their parts.

Their music is akin to a modern day Hollywood Fats Band, or ..... I cannot think of another band to compare them to. Their music is original and fresh, yet savors the traditional styles of blues. For a modern band to perform this style of blues is encouraging. I am glad that the blues is not all about lightning quick guitar riffs and rock influenced rhythms. This band proves that the blues is not only still alive, but *inspirational*. Don't get the idea that their music is not energetic however. If you don't dance, tap, hop up and down or otherwise be moved by "H.M. Stomp" then you must be clinically unresponsive (dead).

There are 12 songs on the CD, most written by the trio, but others are covers by the likes of Bo Diddley, Jimmy Reed and Robert Lockwood Jr. James' vocals are exceptional and complement the music perfectly. Visiting on the CD are Henry Gray and David Maxwell on piano, Rob Corritore on harp, Sam Lay and Willie Hayes on drums.

I don't know what else to say about this CD other than you need it in your collection. It is almost certain to win an award this year and to be one of the best sellers of the year. Get it while supplies last!

# Cathy Lemons and Johnny Ace Lemonace Vizztone Records CD-VTLA-001

When life gives you Lemons, it's great!

"Lemonace" is the latest recording of veteran bassist Johnny Ace and Texas-based blues and soul singer Cathy Lemons. Although it features several special guests, such as blues harpist Paul Oscher, West Coast blues guitarist Tommy Castro and guitarist Kid Andersen, this remains the Ace and Cathy show. Their energy, synergy and chemistry is obvious throughout the dozen tunes on the CD which were mostly written by the talented duo. On this release, they are joined by key band members Artie "Stix" Chavez on drums

(all tracks) and lead, rhythm and slide guitarist Pierre Le Corre. Pianist David Maxwell and slide guitarist Ron Thompson round out the group.

While there are only excellent tunes on the song list, not all are blues; although most at least have a blues influence. There is a healthy dose of funk and soul tunes, before which you might hear the extroverted Ace of Bass "jive -talkin" to his co-star, Ms. Lemons. Ace, when singing, sounds a bit like the Ohio-born, now Nashville-based Stacy Mitchhart, while Lemons conjures up aural sensations that bring Texas singers like Sarah Brown and Angela Strehli to mind --which puts her in excellent company. Her voice is whiskey-drenched and smokey, but smooth enough to still sound great as she gets the most out of her mostly -mid-range vocals. Staying in the pocket works very well for her.

Starting out of the blocks, "Brand New Day," although it has a positive message, does nothing to set the tone for this CD with its rapid-fire funk rhythm guitar. However, you do get a strong sense of the partnership between Ace and Lemons, and a good feel for her vocal quality. A couple of other shortcomings, although not bad ones, are a bit of muddy vocals and some over-the-top lead guitar on the second track.

"Used to These Blues" is a slow, hip-swaying retro soul/funk/blues that really has Lemons singing at her sweetest. The most bluesy numbers are a bit farther down in the second half of the play list, such as the slow, piano-heavy "Gimme a Penny", the Chicago-styled "I'm Not the Woman I Used to Be" and the Texas boogie beat of "Stay".

"Get This Thing Off My Back" is spooky, very slow with a nice stinging electric guitar and some cool vocalizing from Lemons.

Perhaps the best tune of all 12 is track five, "Shoot to Kill." This slow burn contains everything that's right and good about the CD: an evil-sounding greasy slide guitar; clever instrumentation synchronized with the lyrics at just the right spot ["....shoot (fast drum rim shots) to kill"], the growl and rumble of Ace's bass and white hot sensuality from Lemons' earthy vocals.

When life hands you Lemons, listen to it. This is better than lemonade on a hot summer day.
