

# 26th Pedaling Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour

September 28th, 2003



## About the Tour

The Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour is one of the most picturesque rides offered to cyclists in Southern Indiana. The tour winds along the top of the knobs of Southern Indiana with views of fall colors accenting the Ohio River Valley.

This is a leisurely tour for beginner, intermediate, and experienced cyclists. The routes vary from gently rolling to hilly. Once you've ridden this ride, you'll want to return year-after-year.

## Location

The ride will begin and end at Floyd Central High School, located on Old Vincennes Road, Floyd Knobs, Indiana. Take I-64 west from New Albany to the Greenville Exit (Highway 150). Proceed to first stop light, turn left onto Old Vincennes Road. Floyd Central will be approximately 1.5 miles on the left.

## Entry Fee

The pre-registration fee is \$20.00 per adult, children 12 and under \$10.00. The deadline for pre-registration is September 22, 2003. Any entry postmarked AFTER this deadline will be considered a late entry. Late registration fee is \$25.00 for adults, \$15.00 for children.

Included with your registration is "World Famous Chris Cakes Pancake Breakfast" beginning at 8:30 a.m. Get fueled for the ride with a stack of pancakes and side of sausage.



## "Commemorative T-Shirt"

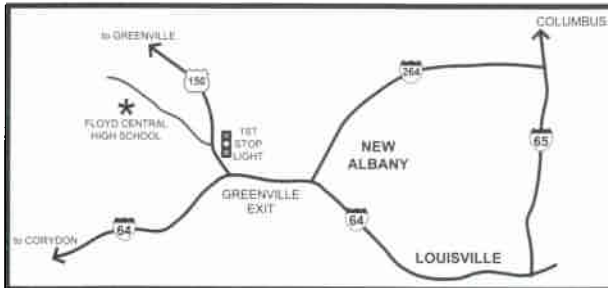

I realize that Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical impediments which would endanger myself or others. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters, or organizers and agree to ride so as not to endanger either myself or others.

I waive, release, discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives (including successors), any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may hereafter accrue to me against the sponsors and promoters of Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour including the Southern Indiana Wheelmen or their sponsors or affiliated organizations and their respective agents, officers and employees for any and all damages, injuries or claims which may be sustained by me indirectly arising out of my participation in Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour. The above agreements and representations are my express understandings of the risks and I assume these voluntarily and freely without coercion or duress. This agreement may not be modified orally and may not be waived in any respect. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle, will wear a helmet as required, and will carry water and personal identification at all times, and agree to abide by the rules of Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour.
